News

JVRB is featured in Kulturerbe-Digital

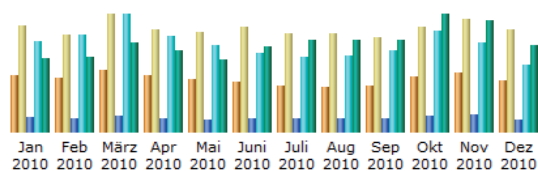
The project database Kulturerbe-Digital that contains information about funded research projects has added the Journal of Virtual Reality and Broadcasting and other open access journals related to the DiPP-Project. The information stored in the database describes the Journal's status in its beginning in 2004 when it was supported by the German Ministerium für Innovation, Wissenschaft, Forschung und Technologie des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen (MIWFT). After 2006, the Journal became a publication hosted persistently at the University of Applied Sciences Düsseldorf.



Submissions

JVRB received 16 submissions in 2010, of which 6 have been accepted and 2 rejected. 1 article has been recommended for a resubmission after major revision. Currently, 7 articles are still under review, no articles have been withdrawn.

The article with the longest processing time has been under review for 330 days and needed 21 review enquiries before three appropriate referees were found. The fastest review process took 73 days and required 14 enquiries.

Reviewers

Currently, 292 international experts with a broad range of research interests from 35 different countries are voluntarily reviewing submissions for JVRB and help to guarantee a high quality standard for the Journal's publications.

The main focus of expertise is on Media Technology, Computer Graphics and Augmented Reality. The field of Interactive Broadcasting is still not sufficiently covered. The number of experts in the field of Virtual Environments has increased since 2009. JVRB has conducted 89 reviews in 2010 with a term of 21 days per review. 345 review enquiries were made. Only 26% of all review enquiries were successful (compared to last years 18%).

Last year, 59 reviews were submitted in time or earlier. Again, the fastest review took one day. The most protracted review was finished after 77 days. 34% of all reviews were submitted overdue.

Approximately 21 enquiries per article were necessary to find the reviewers. The number increased compared to 2009. The average processing time was 190 days (from submission to notification).
