

# **Submissions**

JVRB received 33 submissions in 2007, of which 27 have been accepted and eleven rejected. Currently, 17 articles are still under review.

The article with the longest processing time has been under review for 151 days and needed eight review enquiries before appropriate three referees were found. The fastest review process took 28 days and required six enquiries.

# Reviewers

Currently, 179 international experts with a broad range of research interests from 29 different countries are voluntarily reviewing submissions for JVRB and help to guarantee a high quality standard for the Journal's publications.

The main focus of expertise is on Media Technology, Computer Graphics and Augmented Reality. The fields of Virtual Environments and Interactive Broadcasting are not sufficiently covered yet.

JVRB has conducted 121 reviews in 2007 with a term of 21 days per review. The fastest completed review took 14 days, the most protracted, but completed review took 88 days. About 88% of all reviews are submitted overdue, 12% are processed in time or even faster. The avarage runtime for a review is 60 days.
